In case of a fire

- If the fire alarm sounds – a continuous electronic bell – you must evacuate the building via the nearest route.
- All exits are clearly marked.
 - Fire wardens will direct you towards the best exit route from the courtyard.
 - Lifts must **not** be used.
 - Please make sure you take your badge with you as it will be checked on re-entry.
 - Every **Monday at 11:00hrs** there is a fire alarm test. This will involve the alarm ringing for a few seconds. **Do not evacuate, it is a test only.**
