Conscience wines

White

Jardins De Gascogne Blanc, Plaimont 2021 £29.00

France, Gascony, sp, vg

Lemon-lime in colour with a pronounced nose of cut grass and citrus on the nose. Fresh and lively on the palate, well balanced with notes of grapefruit, green apple, a touch of passion fruit and a subtle floral character on the finish.

Catarratto 'Contrade Bellusa' Mondo del Vino 2021 £31.50

Southern Italy, Sicily, sp, org

Sicilian Catarratto sourced entirely from organic vineyards which sit on soils made up of silt, limestone, sand, and clay. A pale straw colour with a fresh and zesty nose. The palate is crisp and balanced, evocative notes of Sicilian melon, white blossom and grapefruit are in abundance with a citrus acidity and a subtle mineral complexity on the finish.

Sauvignon Blanc, Domaine de la Grande Courtade 2021 £35.50

France, Languedoc, sp, org, vg

Pale lemon in colour with green highlights. A nose of boxwood, grapefruit, and a touch of exotic fruits. On the palate, the mouthfeel is lively and expressive with notes of elderflower, white grapefruit, pineapple, and passion fruit. A zesty citrus acidity balances the aromatic nature of the wine which finishes with a flinty, mineral note.

Bodegas Neleman Chardonnay Muscat 2021 £38.50

Spain, Valencia, sp, org, vg

The chardonnay in this wine was late picked to achieve an advanced point of ripeness, the muscat was harvested early to retain crisp acidity levels and subtle floral notes. Fresh floral aromas on the nose follow through to the palate with notes of white peach and citrus. Well balanced with a fresh finish.

Bottled with a helix cork which acts as a 'corkscrew cap'.

Rosé

Jardins de Gascogne Rouge, Plaimont 2021 £29.00

France, Gascony, sp, vg

Made from a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot, the grapes are harvested at night to retain freshness. The grapes are left on their skins for up to 8 hours to extract colour and flavour before being fermented and matured in stainless steel tanks. The resulting wine is pale cherry pink in colour with notes of raspberries and pink lady apples. Well balanced with a fresh acidity and a fruity finish makes this wine very easy drinking.

Chiaretto di Bardolino, Agricola Gorgo 2021 £36.00

Italy, Veneto, sp, org, vg

A fresh, fun, and fruity rosé from the Veneto region of Italy. Made from the classic grapes of the region; Corvina, Rondinella and Molinara. The nose has delicious aromas of summer fruits which follow onto the palate which has a lovely texture due to 3 months of ageing on fine lees. Red fruit flavours are ripe, with an abundance of cherries, strawberries and raspberries combined with a fresh, floral note and a crisp acidity.

Conscience wines

Red

Jardins De Gascogne Rouge, Plaimont 2020 £29.00

France, Gascony, sp, vg

This blend of Tempranillo and Petit Verdot is a beautiful ruby red in colour. The nose is pronounced with aromas of blackberries and hints of violets. The palate is full and smooth with notes of blackberries, redcurrants and a touch of sweet spice. Well integrated tannins add structure to the wine which finishes long and fruity.

Nero d' Avola 'Contrade Bellusa' Terre Siciliane 2020 £31.50

Southern Italy, Sicily, sp, org

Contrade Bellusa Nero d' Avola is grown on organic vineyards in Sicily on soils consisting of calcareous clay with a rich iron component. A rich, ruby red in colour with violet reflections and a pronounced nose of dark cherries and bramble fruits. The palate is medium bodied with juicy flavours of cherry jam, raspberries, and a spicy finish. Excellent balance of acidity, ripe fruits, and soft tannins.

Rioja Crianza 'Organic' Fincas de Azabache 2016 £36.50

Spain, Rioja, sp, bio, vg

An organic wine which has a deep red robe with ruby borders. Good aromatic intensity with predominant red berries, nuances of maturity, toasty, spicy and balsamic from the wood. This Rioja is tasty and complex in the mouth with a good structure and well-integrated fruit flavours of redcurrants, cherries, and plums. Long lasting on the finish with a pleasant dominance of mature fruit.

Lirac 'Moon Apoge' Domaine des Carabiniers 2019 £46.50

France, Rhone Valley, sp, bio, vg

Lirac is an appellation on the western side of southern Rhone opposite Châteauneuf-du-Pape. This biodynamic Lirac has a purity of fruit characteristic of the region with notes of spices, liquorice and garrigue. A heady, powerful, and hearty wine.



Core wines

White

El Zafiro Blanco 2021 £24.50

Spain, Extremadura, vg

A fresh and lively white from the far west of Spain that combines the local Pardina grape variety with the renowned and supple Chardonnay. Modern winemaking preserves crisp green herb and floral aromas with white fruits such as apple and peach on the palate balanced by a zesty, citrus acidity and a crisp finish.

Hamilton Heights Chardonnay 2021 £26.00

Australia, Riverland

An elegant Aussie Chardonnay, bright lemon in colour with a fresh nose full of ripe peach and citrus. The palate has a nice weight with flavours of ripe mango, pineapple and peach with a crisp acidity and green apple notes. The tropical notes linger on the palate finishing long and refined.

Boatman's Drift Chenin Blanc, Villiersdorp 2021 £28.50

South Africa, Overberg, vg

Boatman's Drift takes its name from the 18th century legend of a ship which was lost off the Cape of Good Hope in a storm. This wine is a pale lemon in colour with a bouquet of apple and white flowers. The palate is crisp with notes of white peach, mango and guava and a fresh and zesty acidity.

Barrel Jumper Viognier, Villiersdorp 2021 £32.00

South Africa, Overberg, vg

Named after speed skaters who would leap over multiple barrels in barrel jumping competitions, and just like those daring skaters, this South African Viognier is packed full of character. Apricot, orange blossom and subtle tropical notes of dried pineapple combine with a fresh grapefruit acidity leaving a long and refreshing impression on the palate.

Pecorino 'Tor Del Colle' 2021 £34.00

Italy, Abruzzo, vg

A crisp and fresh Pecorino from Abruzzo; lemon-green in colour with blossom and grapefruit aromas on the nose. The palate is dry with a zesty citrus acidity and notes of white peach, pear, and green apples.

Picpoul de Pinet 'Trois Mats' 2021 £37.00

France, Languedoc, vg

A bright, fresh Languedoc white from the coastal flatlands of Sete which abounds with fragrant aromas of white flowers, quince and anis followed by ginger and citrus notes. It is lively on the palate with notes of lemon, melon and honey finishing crisp and dry with matured crystallised citrus fruits.

Wairau River Estate Sauvignon Blanc 2022 £38.50

New Zealand, Marlborough, sp

Intense lifted notes of ripe tropical fruits and citrus on the nose. Refined and elegant, displaying a finely textured palate with flavours of guava and stone fruit. Wonderfully expressive with a fresh, dry finish. Expressive on the palate, finishing with great length. This fashionable white wine is a benchmark by which new world sauvignons are judged. Cool fermentation in stainless steel tanks help preserve the intense fruit flavours.

Chablis Domaine Alain Gautheron 2021 £48.50

France, Burgundy, sp, vg

The Gautheron estate has been family owned for five generations making very traditional Chablis from 25ha of vineyard. Their Chablis offers fresh, floral aromas, apple fruit and complex, rich mineral character derived from the subtle influence of the chalky vineyard soils. Fermentation and maturation is in vat to preserve the fresh steely flavours and lively balanced citrus finish.

Core wines

Rosé

La Loupe Carignan Rosé 2021 £27.50

France, Languedoc, vg

This Languedoc rosé is a delightful expression of fresh red summer fruits, which immediately transport you to the south of France. The wine is made protectively with fermentation taking place in steel to preserve the fresh aromas and flavours of Carignan. The result is a rosé with a soft pink colour with an intense bouquet of wild strawberry, redcurrant, and raspberry along with lovely floral notes of lilac, violet and primrose. Fruity and fresh on the palate accompanied by notes of garrigue, mint and pepper. A perfect summer wine, easy-drinking and very fresh.

Provence Rosé, 'Essenciel' Château Paradis 2021 £39.00

France, Coteaux d'Aix en Provence, sp, vg

At Château Paradis nestling on the slopes to the north of this historic town they hand make a delicious Provençal rosé which is made by the saignée method of `bleeding` the fermenting juice from the skins to preserve delicacy and character. It has a rose-petal colour and is elegant and dry with aromatic fruit aromas derived from a vibrant blend of Cabernet and Syrah.

Heppington Vineyards Pinot Noir Rosé 2020 £45.00

England, Kent, vg

Heppington is a single-estate family vineyard, nestled in the chalky north downs in east Kent. We aim to produce delicious sparkling and still English wines that celebrate the special geology and landscape from which our grapes are grown. This beautiful Pinot Noir rosé has delicate notes of nectarine, crisp red apple, pomegranate, and cranberry.



Core wines

Red

El Zafiro Tinto 2020 £24.50

Spain, Extremadura, vg

From the high Sierras of southwestern Spain this inspired blend combines the cherry and strawberry fruit character of the local Tempranillo with the spice and structure of Shiraz. Fresh and focussed young fruit lends vigour to a mid-weight palate that is supple and balanced.

Hamilton Heights Shiraz 2020 £26.00

Southeast Australia

Bright ruby red in colour, this Aussie Shiraz is bursting full of inviting blackcurrant and blackberry aromas on the nose. The palate is smooth and soft with juicy black fruit flavours and a hint of spicy pepper. Soft tannins give structure to the wine which has a long and polished finish.

Merlot 'Le Tuffeau', Les Vignobles Foncalieu 2020 £28.50

France, Languedoc, vg

A juicy Merlot, bursting full of ripe black plum, damson, and elderberry. Well balanced with soft tannins and a medium acidity which complements the ripe fruit flavours.

Punto Alto Malbec, Proemio 2020 £29.50

Argentina, Mendoza, sp, org, vg

This organic Malbec is grown in the vineyards of Mendoza. A dark purple in colour with bramble fruits and black cherries on the nose. The palate has great concentration with velvety texture, dark fruits and chocolate on the finish.

Whale Point Pinot Noir 2020 £32.00

Greece, Macedonia

This Pinot Noir from Macedonia is a pale ruby red in colour with a soft nose of redcurrants and red cherries. The palate is very smooth with a core of red fruit flavours and sweet spices supported by supple tannins giving structure to wine. The finish is long and smooth with the red cherry and raspberry notes lingering on the palate.

Montepulciano d'Abruzzo Riserva 'Tor Del Colle' 2017 £34.00

Central Italy, Abruzzo

Intense purple in colour with intense aromas of blackberries and cherries. The palate is round and rich with notes of ripe berry fruit, sweet black cherries a touch of liquorice and a distinctive spicy character from 12 months ageing in wooden casks. Chewy tannins support the palate which finishes long and fruity.

Château le Gardera, Bordeaux Superieur 2018 £41.50

France, Bordeaux, sp

This fantastic property is among the best of the appellation, producing firm, rich wine from 60% Merlot and 40% Cabernet Sauvignon. Busting full of ripe berry fruits with generous tannins, balanced acidity and a subtle toast and sweet spice character from 12 months ageing in French barrels.

Fleurie 'Cote de Poncié' Domaine Patrick Tranchand 2019 £48.50

France, Beaujolais, sp, vg

Located at an elevation of 320 metres in the climate of Poncie, the vines are an average of 65 years old and sit on soils composed of sand and granite. The wine is aged for 8 months in a combination of concrete and stainless-steel tanks. Bright ruby red with fresh raspberries on the nose. The palate is soft with a silky mouthfeel and subtle tannins, notes of red cherries and violets on the finish.

Sparkling wine & champagne

Thomson & Scott Noughty Organic Sparkling Chardonnay £27.00

Spain, vg

Traditional winemaking in stainless steel vats, de-alcoholised by vacuum distillation and then the wine is lightly carbonated. Elegant pale colour with a crisp and ripe apple scent accompanied by a touch of sweetness. Subtle flavours with a lingering finish.

Veuve de Valmante, Compagnie des Grands Vins N.V. £34.00

France (Charmat Method), vg

An easy drinking soft and well-rounded sparkler with hints of light summer fruits on the palate and crisp acidity. It has a pale golden colour with a light persistent mousse and off dry finish. Vibrant and fun, it makes for a great party wine.

Prosecco Spumante 'Borgo del Col Alto' Extra Dry NV £35.50

Italy, Veneto, vg

Prosecco is the fashionable dry sparkling wine produced from Glera (formally known as prosecco) grapes grown in the hills of Treviso, Veneto region. It is a pale and delicate wine with a fine mousse and persistent fine bubbles. The clean fruity aromatic bouquet contains hints of flowers, honey and apple leading to a well-balanced, light, and fresh palate.

Champagne De Malherbe Brut N.V. £55.00

France, Epernay, sp, vg

A soft and well-rounded Champagne that exhibits typical attractive brioche aromas with hints of red fruits and citrus. The extended maturation on the lees gives a supple balance, with a hint of minerality that makes this wine a classic example of regional terroir. Well-structured with a persistent mousse, it is round and full in the mouth, with hints of vanilla and biscuits on the finish.

Hindleap Classic Cuvee Brut, Bluebell Vineyards 2015 £61.00

England, East Sussex, vg

The Hindleap vineyard was planted in 2005 on chalk and sandstone soils adjacent to the Bluebell Railway and on the fringes of the Ashdown forest. Fragrant and floral on the nose, the palate has notes of orange zest, citrus, white blossom, and fresh green apple. The creamy mousse is well balanced by a crisp and fresh acidity.

Champagne Laurent-Perrier La Cuvee Brut £80.00

France, vg

The expression of the perfect year is that of a great Champagne wine that over time has developed a depth, intensity, and aromatic complexity, yet maintains its freshness and acidity. To create such a wine, Laurent-Perrier will rely on the characteristics of the great vintage years of Champagne: freshness, structure, and finesse.

Champagne, Brut, Laurent Perrier Rosé £95.00

France

Cuvée rosé was created in 1968 from the boldness and unique savoir-faire of Laurent-Perrier. Perfected at each stage of its making, Cuvée rosé is acknowledged for its consistency and its high quality. It is characterized by its ripe red fruit aromas, a high intensity and great freshness.
